LANE ALLOCATION: All lanes seeded based on Meet Manager protocols

MULTICLASS: MC athletes now also compete in 9/10, 11, 12/13 age groups. Where numbers do not warrant separate events age groups will be combined into one event. Separate medals will be awarded.

PROGRESSION: Only the Winner of each race will progress the State Swimming Carnival. Any dead heats for first place will result in a re-swim of the two tied swimmers on the day.

RULES: Swimming is conducted under the rules of Australian Swimming Inc. unless otherwise stated- Please familiarise yourself with these before the event.

PROTESTS: If anyone feels the need to lodge a protest in regards to an event- it must be done on the day of competition through the correct procedure according to the "PROTESTS AND APPEALS POLICY found on the SSV website.

RELAYS: All relays will start at the deep end of the pool. Swimmers 2 and 4 must start in the pool at the shallow end. In the Medley relay, the Breaststroke and Freestyle swimmers will also start in the water at the shallow end of the pool.
