Please note the following:

All age groups per permitted to wear spikes for 100m, 200m, Hurdles, Relay, Long Jump, Triple Jump and High Jump.

Spikes are not permitted in the 800m or the 1500m events - for any age groups.

FIELD event competitors will only have 3 attempts with the top two on distance progressing to the Victorian State event.

All Track Events are TIMED FINALS. The top 3 runners from each timed final, where there is more than one final, will be held in a holding area directly after they compete. Once both/all timed finals have been conducted the times for all athletes are combined and the fastest three will receive medallions.

No personal batons for relay events will be permitted. A baton will be supplied by School Sport Victoria for all relay events.

There can be no equal second places. Re runs or second best throws/jumps will apply.

To advance to the State Championships, a student or team must place first or second in their event.

There will be NO starting blocks supplied by School Sport Victoria at the Southern Metro Region event, if competitors want to use starting blocks which they are most welcome to- they must be supplied by the competitor.

The South Metro Coordinator for School Sport Victoria will have the final say in any disputes arising from all proceedings.

MULTICLASS: MC athletes now also compete in 9/10, 11, 12/13 age groups. Where numbers do not warrant separate events age groups may be combined into one event, but separate medals will be awarded for each age group.

PROTESTS: If anyone feels the need to lodge a protest in regards to an event- it must be done on the day of competition through the correct procedure according to the "PROTESTS AND APPEALSPOLICY found on the SSV website.
