Balls recommended Junior Format Stage 1 Modified Cricket Balls include:

- Gray-Nicolls Fusion Weight 130g/21cm circumference/Colour Pink
- Kookaburra Star 137g/22 cm/Pink, Red & White
- Aero Safetyball Matchweight 140g/22cm/Red
- Competing teams will need to bring their own match balls for State Quarter-finals & also practice balls. Match balls will be provided for State Semi-Finals & Finals.
- A competent scorer and a scorebook.
- A square leg umpire
