Importance of school sport to schools and students

Sport participation provides opportunities for students to be physically active and also contributes to improving mental wellbeing and resilience – alongside improving social interaction, fun and enjoyment, relief of tension, self-expression, achievement and building confidence.

Supporting Government and school priorities

The <u>Education State</u> is about achieving excellence and creating opportunities for all Victorian students in all aspects of their education. School sport is integral to supporting the achievement of the Education State targets, in particular <u>happy, healthy and resilient</u> kids and <u>pride and confidence in our schools</u>, across the Victorian education system.

In addition, the Joint Ministerial **Statement on Physical Activity** for Children and Young People sets out how schools, in partnership with families and the community, can set children on a physical activity path for life.

SSV supports schools in providing sport opportunities for students which:

- Aligns with the <u>Active Schools Framework</u>, supporting schools to take a whole school approach to physical activity, including through the <u>Active Schools Toolkit</u>.
- Contributes to meeting the minimum required amount of physical and sport education, as outlined in the **Physical and Sport Education policy**.

Eligible schools can access funding to support school sport, including:

- Active School Grants
- Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund
- Sporting Schools

In addition, a range of sporting programs are available through the **Positive Start program in 2022 and 2023 for eligible schools**.

SSV Membership Categories and Fees

SSV offers schools three levels of membership categories: **Full members** (any Government school), **Associate members** (any non-Government school) and **Affiliate members** (any non-Government secondary school).
