- 7. SSV reserves the right to disqualify any student it finds to be acting in breach of these T&Cs.
- 8. SSV reserves the right to cancel or amend the Competition and these T&Cs without notice. Any changes to the Competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by SSV posting to this webpage.
