### Information

Winner of Division 1 progress to the Regional Winter Sports Day on **Tuesday the 3rd of August** 2021 in Swan Hill.

More information will be given to those teams invited to attend.

Duration of each game 25 minutes (2 X 12 minutes with 1 minute to change ends). Teams are not to group together at the changeover but to move straight to their positions and the umpire restarts play at his discretion. Each venue will have their own timekeeper and recorder of games. Between games move quickly between venues to be ready to begin.

### **Max Carroll will oversee the day and allocate roles.**

Games will begin and end with two loud horn blasts, half time will be indicated with one loud horn blast. (Note no horn to indicate start of second half of match)

### **Scoring      3 points for a win                      2 points for a draw                      1 point for a loss**

At the conclusion of the round robin a ladder will be drawn using the above scoring system. Schools that are equal on points will be ordered by determining each schools average for and against. % (eg. Total points for day divided by the total points against X 100 for the day)

- **Division 1** Pennants and certificates will be presented on the day. Division 1 teams will be playing for the \*Jim Wallis Cup\*# which is a yearly cup, engraved and kept at the winning school for a year and then returned to be presented again next year.
- **Division 2** Pennants and certificates will be presented on the day. Division 2 teams are not eligible to progress to the next level.
