

# **2024 Cross Country Event Information Pack**

#### This is a combined Secondary & Primary Event

- Athletes will be required to collect a race bib at the RACE VENUE prior to their event.
- The distribution of Race Bibs will be done in the order that the events are conducted on the day
- Students should collect their Race Bib up to 1 hour prior to the start time of the race they are competing in
- The Race Bib will need to be pinned to the FRONT of the athletes shirt. The Race Bibs have a chip in them that will record the athletes time as they cross over the finish line
- <u>At the conclusion of the race, Bibs will need to be removed and left in the tubs at the finish line.</u> It is very important that students return their Race Bibs at the finish line, Schools will be invoiced \$5 (per bib) for any that are not returned
- Students should be aware of the age group they are competing in; 9/10 years, 11 years, or 12/13 years (NB: There is a 12/13 Years Primary and 12/13 Years Secondary event). Students' age groups are determined by their age as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024
- Multi Class athletes 9/10 years, 11 years and 12/13 year old Multi Class will be included in events #15 & #16; Secondary Multi Class Students 12-14 years will compete in events #5 & 6; 15-16 years Multi Class will compete in events #7 & 8; 17-20 years Multi Class will be included in events #9 & 10.
- No warming up is permitted on the course proper. Walking the course is permitted. Athletes being paced are subject to disqualification.
- Athletes need to listen for PA Announcements calling for them to make their way to the start line. If an athlete is unsure as to whether their event has been announced they can make their way to the start line no sooner than 10mins prior to the advertised start time for their event. The Starters Marshal will supervise athletes at the start line until the Starter begins each race.
- Finishing Procedure As students cross the finishing line their time is automatically recorded by the Tomato Timing Results software. Placegetters will be announced on the day with medals being presented to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> placegetters. Secondary Teams a maximum of 4 medals will be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed teams
- Protests will be heard on the day of competition ONLY. Protests received after the day of competition will not be accepted. Protests need to be made immediately an incident occurs or within 10minutes of the conclusion of the event. Protests concerning results need to be made within 10minutes of the results being posted. Appeals can only be made by the school or a school representative Protest Form, Appeals & Grievances Policy
- All results will be posted on the SSV website following the day of the event
- The course will be marked with flags and cones. Officials will be located at various points around the course. The course is subject to alteration at any time. Should a student require assistance or first aid they should seek the attention of one of the course marshalls wearing a yellow fluro vest with a 2 way radio. If students leave the course or decide not to finish they must immediately report to the Finish Line so we can account for all athletes on the day.

## Qualifying for SSV State Cross Country Championships:

- Primary & Secondary Individual The top 12 individual runners in each age group progress to SSV State Championships
- Secondary Team All Individual runners are automatically entered into the Teams Category. A
  Team comprises of a min. of 3, max. of 4 runners competing for the same school. The team score is
  determined by the combined placings of the top 3 runners from the one school. In the event of a
  tie, the team with the best placed 'third' runner shall be declared the winner. If no school has min.
  of 3 runners in top 12, the next best placed runner outside of the 12 will be considered as part of
- The Top 12 individual runners in each Multi Class age group progress to SSV State Cross Country Championships
- Reminder re wearing of Spikes For '12/13 years SECONDARY', '12/13 years PRIMARY and Under' students are NOT permitted to wear spiked footwear or footwear with blades or cleats constructed of hard plastic. For 14 years SECONDARY and older students spikes may be worn but they must be pyramid spikes no longer that 12mm.
