### COMPETITION STRUCTURE

- Competitors will participate in a split round robin fixture, with cross over finals.
- There will be two pools. The top two players who have won the most matches won will progress to the cross over final.
- At the conclusion of round robin matches, if two players are equal on matches won, then the face to face match between the two players who tied will be used to determine the winner.
- All matches are first to 4 games with a tie break at 3 all.
- In all games 'Sudden Death' is played at deuce (the player that wins the next point, wins the game). The receiver elects the side that the server serves to.
- Competition structure may be altered due a range of factors including player availability and weather conditions etc.

### OFFICIALS/COACHING

- Children are to umpire and call lines of their own matches.
- If there is a dispute that cannot be resolved the court supervisor/referee can be called onto the court to resolve the problem.
- No coaching is allowed during any match. Parents and players are reminded of the Code of Conduct that applies at all School Sport events.

### DRESS

Competitors must be dressed in their school sports uniform or in neat tennis clothing. Tracksuits may not be worn during play. Board shorts (surf shorts) are not acceptable. Shirts with designs, large manufacturers logos or advertising are not acceptable. Tennis shoes with flat tread must be worn. Players not correctly dressed will not be permitted to compete.

### EQUIPMENT

Each player to provide their own personal equipment.

### FIRST AID

Schools must bring their own first aid and trained staff for first aid on the day. Schools must bring their own ice packs to the event. If required, schools must bring their own students epipens and asthma kits to the event. Schools are responsible for their own student's anaphylaxis and asthma equipment.
