LAWN BOWLS - PRIMARY

Match Format

Play will be two bowl fours, with three sides in a team making 12 in total.

In Round Robin matches play will continue for 5 ends or 40 minutes, whichever comes first. If time elapses, the end in progress will be declared void.

There will be three games of 5 ends/40 minutes, with the best of three games deemed the winner (eg: 3-0, 2-1, 1-2, 0-3).

The mat is placed by the winner of the previous end, and can be placed anywhere on the centre, chalk line. The mat must be touching the chalk line at all times.

The jack will not be rolled; it will be placed at the start of each end, at the 'T' (2 metres from the ditch).

If during play the jack is knocked out of bounds, or in the ditch, the end will continue, but with the jack re-spotted at the 'T'.

Bowling order: A1, B1, A1, B1; A2, B2, A2, B2...

Further to this The Lead, Second and Third (A1, A2, A3) all at the bowling end, with the Skip (A4) at the head (end with all the bowls). Once A1 B1, A2 B2, A3 B3 have had all their bowls they all walk up the other end and the two skips would walk down to the bowling end to have their bowls.

Pool Winners

Two points will be awarded for a win, one point for a draw.

Matches in the round-robin section will be decided by 'ends won'.

At the end of the round-robin, the top team in Pool A & top team in Pool B with the most points will be the two finalists.

If two teams are equal on points, then the winners will be determined by head to head. If this was a draw, then a four player, one end bowl off will occur (school teams select their best four players). This is the same for the Final if the end score is level after 40 minutes.

Team Size

Twelve (12) players make up a team, with three 4's in each side. This may consist of boys only, girls only or mixed.

Rules

Matches are to be played under Bowls Australia's rules; unless otherwise stated.
