## Please note the following:

All age groups are permitted to wear spikes for 100m, 200m, Hurdles, Relay, Long Jump, Triple Jump and High Jump.

However- NO spikes can be worn in the two distance events for any Age group- 800 and 1500 metres.

No personal batons for relay events will be permitted. A baton will be supplied by School Sport Victoria for all relay events.

There can be no equal first or second places. Re runs or extra throws/jumps will apply.

To advance to Southern Metropolitan Regional Championships, a student or team must place first or second in their event.

Ribbons will be awarded to the first three placegetters in every event.

The Peninsula Division Coordinator for School Sport Victoria, will have the final say in any disputes arising from all proceedings.
