Wet Weather:

Equipment:

- Hot Shots tennis racquets size 21, 23 or 25. <u>If you do not have these please let Sam Condon Tennis Victoria Staff Member know SCondon@Tennis.com.au</u> No full size racquets will be allowed.
- Teams are required to supply their own first aid supplies, drink bottles, hats etc.

Game Format:

- Each singles and doubles match will be an 8 minute match using numeric scoring e.g 1-0, 1-1, 1-2, with a 3min break to collect scores and change players over
- Players need to be ranked in order of ability (1-8) and can only move down one spot when substitutes are made during the competition
- Players can only be substituted after each round, not during the round
