



## SCHOOL SPORT VICTORIA BEHAVIOUR GUIDELINES

Following the selection of my child in the Championship conducted under the auspices of School Sport Australia, I agree that:

1. My student will:
  - Obey all reasonable instructions or requests made by team officials and Host State Officials.
  - Co-operate with teachers, fellow students and behave in a manner acceptable to SSV
  - Accept that a total ban exists during the Championship on the partaking of alcohol, drugs (except on medical prescription), the driving of motor vehicles and smoking.
2. I understand that any instances of poor behaviour during the selection, training, travelling and attendance at the Championship, including participation in games, matches or events will be brought to the attention of myself and the school my student attends.
3. In the case of any loss, injury or damage sustained by my student incidental to, during, or as a result of participation in trials, training, matches / games / events, I will make no claim against School Sport Victoria / School Sport Australia. I further agree that teachers involved with the team have my full authority to take any necessary action and I will meet any additional expense.
4. Should my student's behaviour be deemed by Team Management to be such that his / her continued participation is undesirable, then I will arrange, in conjunction with the teachers, for their immediate collection and return to home and that I will meet any additional expenses necessary.
5. I understand my student must abide by School Sport Australia General Policies & Guidelines that students selected in teams attending a School Sport Australia event must attend all activities and remain for the duration of the Championship.
6. I understand my child must abide by the School Sport Australia Student Accommodation Framework. As Victoria does not participate in billeting, I have indicated that my child will stay with family / friends.
