Swimming, 10-19 Years, Boys and Girls

The School Sport Australia (SSA) Swimming Championships will be held in Gold Coast, QLD. The <u>10-12</u> <u>Years</u> event will be from Wednesday 24 July to Saturday 27 July, 2024. The <u>13-19 Years</u> event will be from Saturday 27 July to Wednesday 31 July, 2024.

Eligibility

- 10 19 years of age as at 31 December 2024
- Comply with the multi class categories for the 2024 SSA Championships where applicable

SSV Member Schools

- Trialing for Team Vic is only possible if your child's school is a financial member of School Sport Victoria (SSV) for 2024
- SSV will contact you if the school your child attends is not a financial member

Trial Progression

• There are no selection trials for any age group for swimming.

State Selection

- Swimmers must nominate and register for Team Vic via the registration link
 https://www.ssv.vic.edu.au/team-vic/pages/swimming.aspx by 11.59pm Friday 19 April 2024. Only swimmers nominating via this process will be considered.
- Completing the registration process indicates your intent to be available for selection, your intent to swim, if selected, and that you have met the qualifying standards in a qualifying meet in one or more events (see Qualifying Standards below).
- To be considered for selection, you must compete and set one or more standard times as set by SSV (see below), at any of the meets listed below. Multi-class swimmers must meet the minimum point score listed to be eligible
 - o All long course swim meets approved by Swimming Victoria (SV) as 'Qualifying Meets' from Sunday 1 January 2023 to Friday 19 April 2024. This includes the SSV State Championships and any times recorded as Official times on the Swimming Australia database
 - o Finals of each School Sports Association that are SV approved meets, or MM results file provided to SSV
- There is a restriction on the number of swimmers that can be entered in each event but no maximum team size.
- Emergencies will be identified but not named at the time of selection.
- Swimmers will be asked to nominate six (6) preferred **individual** events i.e. stroke and distance. Times are not required. These are only used if a swimmer is eligible for many events and we try to give them their preferences when reallocating events to other swimmers to make a balanced team.
- Long Course times achieved after the selection period, and prior to submission of entries to SSA, will be
 used to update entry times, but will not change individual event selections. The National Database will
 be used to access these times. Short course times will not be used.
- The selected team will be posted on the SSV website in mid May 2024, allowing for performance verification.
- Selection for relays will be confirmed at the Championships. Swimmers will be advised of the number
 of potential relays they will swim on selection, but actual teams may be finalised at the Championships,
 with performances at the Championships able to be used to finalise teams. It is compulsory to swim in
 all relays you are selected for.
- Swimmers need to ensure their results are visible in Results Central. To ensure this go to their Swim Central profile and at the bottom of their details page there is a box titled Hide Results in Public Portal. This box must be unticked so that our selectors can access swimmer results.

SELECTION GUIDELINES

School Sport Australia Championships consists of both educational and sporting components. Being a member of a School Sport Victoria Team Vic representative team provides the opportunity to be involved in all educational and sporting excursions and aim for national selection.

Team Officials run a selection process that is fair and transparent. This process involves the design of guidelines and trial activities, assessment of players and ensuring students, parents and teachers are made aware of this process.

Team members are expected to abide by the following responsibilities:

- Attend all sessions (i.e., including but not limited to initial briefing, training, practice matches, uniform presentation, team photo etc.,) as deemed compulsory by Team Officials.
- Must be accompanied by a parent/carer to the 2024 Championships. Parent/carer is responsible for the travel, meals and accommodation for themselves and their child
- Purchase the compulsory uniform
- Complete and return all team documentation to the Team Manager by the due date
- Pay all team membership invoices by the due date
- Attend all SSA Championship sessions, including the opening and closing ceremonies and the championship team experience as per the SSA Championship Attendance Policy
- Recognise that the SSA Championships are school activities, and the decision-making regarding each team member's participation in those activities or in preparation for those activities, is the responsibility of the Team Officials
- Be respectful of the role of the Team Officials in making decisions regarding each team member's participation in SSA Championship activities or other preparation activities
- Follow COVID-19 guidance to protect yourselves and others and comply with any health advice that is issued.



















Guidelines for selectors

- Only official times (individual or relay) recorded on the Swimming Australia database will be used for selection purposes.
- Gaining a place at any of the above meets does not mean automatic selection in the Team Vic team.
- Where there may be a perceived or actual conflict of interest such as: trial coordinators assessing the selection of a friend or relative, this must be communicated to SSV and a plan to manage the conflict will be developed and implemented.
- Selectors must ensure sufficient swimmers in each gender and age group are selected to fill the events on the program.
- The team will be selected in order of those with the greatest number of highest rated swims in each age group.
- Selectors reserve the right to distribute swims to team members on an equitable basis to maximise the number of individual swims across the team.
- Team balance is critical to selection of the final squad.
