13-19 Years Multiclass Triathlon

The School Sport Australia (SSA) 11–19 Years Aquathlon/Triathlon Championships will be held in **Rockingham**, **Western Australia**, from **Tuesday 12 March – Friday 15 March**, **2024**.

Eligibility:

- Comply with the age groups for the 2024 SSA Championships as of 31 December 2024
- Comply with the multiclass categories for the 2024 SSA Championships where applicable
- Triathlon only: compete in endorsed 'draft legal' selection races (2024 SSA Championships will be conducted in a 'draft legal' format). NOTE: Junior events are non-drafting and are accessible to anyone

SSV Member Schools:

- Trialling for Team Vic is only possible if your child's school is a financial member of School Sport Victoria (SSV) for 2024
- SSV will contact you if the school your child attends is not a financial member

Trials Progression:

- Trial participants are required to participate in at least one selection race to be considered for the team
- Trial participants must register to try out for Team Vic at https://www.ssv.vic.edu.au/team-vic/pages/triathlon.aspx by Thursday 7 December, 2023 AND register for the listed selection events below via the event websites (e.g. registered for Triathlon 2XU Triathlon Series or Aquathlon Victorian Aquathlon State Championships by visiting their website). Please note that the registration for externally provided selection events may close before Thursday 7 December, 2023.
- Trial participants can achieve selection by either an Automatic selection or through a Discretionary selection

State Selection:

- A maximum of 116 students may be selected for the team as per the table below
- Up to 2 emergency students of each gender, in each competition category **may** be selected and offered the opportunity to train with the selected team
- If more than one team emergency is named in a category, the students selected will be listed in priority order
- Any student selected as an emergency must comply with the responsibilities of team members in order to be eligible for selection should a position in the team become available and offered to them

Automatic Selection - Aquathlon

- A trial participant can qualify for automatic selection to the below listed **Aquathlon** teams through their performance in the selection race if:
 - Finish Top 3 in the 17-19 Years Category in the Selection Race
 - Finish Top 3 in the 15-16 Years Category in the Selection Race
 - o Finish Top 3 in the 13-14 Years Category in the Selection Race
 - o Finish Top 3 in the 11-12 Years Category in the Selection Race
 - AND complete the event in a time less than 110% of the winner's time.

Automatic Selection - Triathlon

- A trial participant can qualify for automatic selection to the below listed **Triathlon** teams through their performance in the selection race if:
 - Finish Top 3 in the 17-19 Years (Senior) Category in the Selection Race
 - o Finish Top 3 in the 15-16 Years (Intermediate) Category in the Selection Race
 - Finish Top 3 in the 13–14 Years (Junior) Category in the Selection Race
 - Finish Top 3 in the 13-19 Years Para Athlete Category in the Selection Race
 - AND complete the event in a time less than 110% of the winner's time.

Discretionary Selection

- Team Vic Officials may select trial participants for the remaining positions in the team following the allocation of any automatic positions. This discretion is absolute, and it need not be exercised should the selectors believe the trialist will not be able to adequately meet the performance standards required at the SSA event.
- Results from the 'Discretionary' Race will be considered by Team Vic Officials.
- Trial participants are required to participate in at least one selection race to be considered for the team.
- If relevant, a valid Invitation Request needs to have been submitted to the National Programs Manager.

SELECTION GUIDELINES

School Sport Australia Championships consists of both educational and sporting components. Being a member of a School Sport Victoria Team Vic representative team provides the opportunity to be involved in all educational and sporting excursions and aim for national selection.

Team Officials run a selection process that is fair and transparent. This process involves the design of guidelines and trial activities, assessment of players and ensuring students, parents and teachers are made aware of this process

Team members are expected to abide by the following responsibilities:

- Attend all sessions (i.e., including but not limited to initial briefing, training, practice matches, jumper
 presentation, team photo etc.,) as deemed compulsory by Team Officials including the State Camp (if
 applicable)
- Must be accompanied by a parent/carer to the 2024 Championships. Parent/carer is responsible for the travel, meals and accommodation for themselves and their child
- Purchase the compulsory uniform
- Complete and return all team documentation to the Team Manager by the due date
- Pay all team membership invoices by the due date
- Attend all SSA Championship sessions, including the opening and closing ceremonies and the championship team experience as per the <u>SSA Championship Attendance Policy</u>
- Recognise that the SSA Championships are school activities, and the decision-making regarding each team member's participation in those activities or in preparation for those activities, is the responsibility of the Team Officials
- Be respectful of the role of the Team Officials in making decisions regarding each team member's participation in SSA Championship activities or other preparation activities
- Follow <u>COVID-19</u> <u>guidance to protect yourselves and others</u> and comply with any health advice that is issued.

















Guidelines for selectors

• Where there may be a perceived or actual conflict of interest such as: trial coordinators assessing the selection of a friend or relative, this must be communicated to SSV and a plan to manage the conflict will be developed and implemented.

Selectors are looking for:

- Strong results in selection events
- Positive on and off court / field / course behaviour
- Strong sense of team spirit / good sportsmanship
- Ability to communicate / cooperate with teammates / Team Officials
- Understands rules of the game
- Adequate level of fitness
- Ability to follow instructions
- Ability to control emotions
- Leadership skills
- Carry out above skills under pressure
- Ability to listen to advice
- Team player
